Role of OEDI

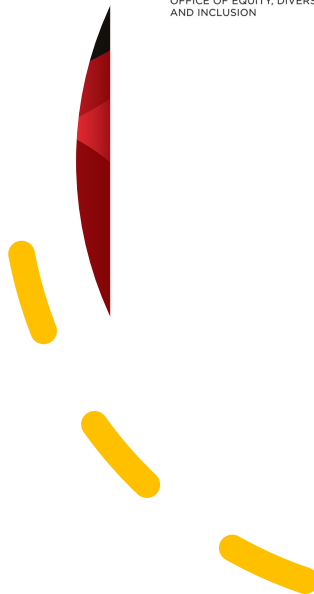
